

SCHEDULE TABLE TENNIS

European Company Sport Games 2017

General provisions

- Organisation:** Vlaamse Tafeltennisliga Oost-Vlaanderen
Main referee: Iserentant Evert
Locations: Sport facility Driebeek – Driebeekstraat 22, 9050 Gentbrugge
- Date:** 22.06.2017 – 24.06.2017
Attendance: Presentation of players is required the latest 30 minutes before the start of their first game of their team.
Awards: The first 3 places from each category will receive medals and diplomas.

Technical provisions

- Rules:** The competition is in accordance with the regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) and the regulations mentioned in this document.
- Requierements:** The organisation will provide approved balls for the competition. We ask the participants to bring their own rackets. Clothing with predominantly white background is not permitted.

Conditions of participation: Properly registered teams in the term, including payment of invoices.

Class divisions:

- Men “Open Class” for all ages
- Men “Senior Class” for 40 years old and over (40+)
- Women “Open Class” for all ages
- Women “Senior Class” for 40 years old and over (40+)
- Mix “Open Class” for all ages
- Mix “Senior Class” for 40 years old and over (40+)

A team consists of minimum 2 and maximum 4 players.

Game model:

The tournament is for three days.
Each team match has 3 individual games in the following order:

Men	Women	Mixed
Men’s double	Women’s double	Mixed double
Men’s single 1	Women’s single 1	Women’s single
Men’s single 2	Women’s single 2	Men’s single

System of play:

Games are played to the best of 3 sets, with a maximum time of 50 min.
Each set is played up to 11 points.
The tournament is using white balls Tibhar Competition ***.

Final placement:

The team that wins 2 games is the winning team.
We always run all three games at the same time e.g. the game will continue till the end even with a score of 2:0.

The winning team gets 3 points; the losing team gets 0 points.

Criteria for the order in a group:

1. points
2. the mutual match
3. the difference in scores of the matches
4. the difference in scores among sets
5. the difference in scores of the points
6. a draw

In case of equality of the scores, we will continue to follow the steps mentioned above. This for the mutual matches of the teams in equality of points.

Results: Results will be hang out in the sports facility. Also each evening all results will be published in the Meeting Center.

Referees: Games on Thursday and Friday will be played without an umpire. The players themselves judge the individual games. We will have a referee for the finals on Saturday.

Objections: Teams can submit a protest against the game or decision in 30 minutes after the game and are obligated for a deposit of 20 EUR, which in case of compliance of your objection will be returned. Potential protest will be addressed to the organisers and the ECSG sport manager.

Special arrangements: Each participant travels and attends at his own risk. Organiser provides first aid only. It is recommended to carry your insurance card with you at all time.

The organiser reserves the right to modify or change the schedule if necessary.

The players are required to be at the court on time based on the time schedule that they are given when signing up. However, if they don't show up within the first 10 min after the start of the game, they automatically loose the match without any exceptions.

Time Schedule:

Thursday 22.06.2017, 9:00 – 18:00 1st round in a pool

Groups system – in all categories

Teams on 1st and 2nd place will go through to the second level of the tournament (there is a progressive k.o. system in all categories for the final place). The team that will not go through to the next level will play progressive k.o. system for the final place. Women's tournament will be played only via group system.

Friday 23.06.2017, 9:00 – 18:00 2nd round in a pool

Continuance of the game – 2nd level (group and progressive k.o. system)

Category Mix Open, Mix 40 + and women's games are held on Friday.

Saturday 22. 6. 2013, 09:00 – 12:00

Final program 9:00 - 12:00 Finals

Category Men Open and Men 40 +

13:00 Award ceremony

Game model:

MEN 40+: 10 groups of 4 teams. Next round will be played in 8 groups of 5 teams.

First round winners + 2 best runners up (decided on Friday) will play for place 1 to 12 on Saturday.

MEN OPEN: 7 groups of 4 or 5 teams. Next round will be played in 8 groups of 3, 4 or 5 teams. Final matches for Best 12 on Saturday.

MIX OPEN; MIX 40+; WOMEN OPEN and WOMEN 40+

Will play together in 4 first round groups of 4.

MIX OPEN: 1 final group of 4 to determine standings.

MIX 40+: 4 first round winners + best runner up will play for 1st to 5th place. Others will play in a group of 5 for 6th to 10th place. Test match between runners up is possible on Thursday.

WOMEN: 1 group of 3 to determine standings.
